Professor Mohamed Errami (1958–2020)



With sadness in my heart, I inform you that Prof. Mohamed Errami, Rector of Abdelmalek Essaâdi University, died on the 18th of September 2020, due to complications of Corona virus infection.

I have known and collaborated with Prof. Errami since 2012.

Thanks to his strong vision, kindness and trust in me and my colleagues in Tetouan, I was able to start developing the MeSHe project. This cooperation has resulted during the past six years, two Ph.D. thesis and several scientific publications.
